### Purpose:

The purpose of this Standard Operating Procedure is to establish expectation and consistency for jobsite safety signage and company branding.

### Procedure:

- 1) Jobsite signage is required on all Crain Construction project sites unless contractual obligations, site restrictions, or safety do not allow.
- 2) The Project Superintendent will be responsible for incorporating jobsite signage into project planning.
- 3) All signage must be from the approved list of branded options found on the [Crain Signage Website](#). This site link can also be found on the [www.crainportal.com](http://www.crainportal.com). Signs can be ordered through the office admin, PM or Superintendent as needed and charged to your project.
- 4) Superintendents may also use signage from jobsite to jobsite if they are appropriate and in good condition.
- 5) If alternate signage is requested, this must be approved by the VP of Operations prior to installation on jobsite. Work with the Office Admin to order these signs.
- 6) Below is a list of the minimum required Jobsite signage.
  - i. Crain Construction, Inc. (Company Signage – 30x42)
    - (1) To be located on public side of fencing (or facing public side of project perimeter if fencing is not permitted). Install a minimum of one company sign per adjacent roadway.
  - ii. Construction Entrance Sign (size to be determined based on project needs)
  - iii. Construction Office Sign
  - iv. PPE Description and Requirements (PPE Man)
    - (1) To be located at or near all project entrances, visible from the entrance point of view.
    - (2) Crain Hard Hat Area signs (located at project entrances and/or areas where active work is being performed)
    - (3) Crain Values Signage (to be displayed in the Crain office onsite)
    - (4) Proceed with Caution-Ongoing Construction sign at entrances or areas with construction traffic.
    - (5) No Soliciting signage for office area
    - (6) Crain safety cultural signage for different areas around the site.
- B) Additional signage may include:
  - i. Tower Crane Signage
  - ii. Traffic Control Signage
  - iii. Safety culture signage (these are encouraged to be placed throughout the project site)
  - iv. Other signage on Website
